## Essential Standards/Skills to Know:

1. I will determine the meaning of words and phrases as they are used in a text, including figurative, connotative, and technical meanings; analyze the impact of rhymes and other repetitions of sounds on a specific verse or stanza of a poem or section of a story or drama (RL 7.4). (Quarter 1)
